SARS-COV-2 RNA, QL, RT PCR (COVID-19)

Notes

You have a **NEGATIVE** Covid-19 Test Result.

A negative test result does not completely rule out being infected with COVID-19. If you have symptoms of COVID-19, the virus may not be detected at the time your specimen was collected. It is still possible that you were very early in your infection at the time of your specimen collection and that you could not develop IgG. Also, you must be retested later and still develop the IgG. For all these reasons, it is important to follow CDC guidance at <https://www.cdc.gov/media/releases/2020/s0501-covid-19-testing.html>, including but not limited to frequent hand washing, social distancing, wearing a face covering, covering coughs and sneezes, monitoring symptoms, and cleaning and disinfecting of frequently touched surfaces – even after a negative test result.
